The Epistle to the Romans

1. Obedience to the faith
2. Your faith is spoken of
3. Mutual faith
4. God is revealed from faith to faith

8. Jesus was set forth as a propitiation ... through faith
9. God is the justifier of the one who has faith in Jesus

14. Abraham received the sign of circumcision, a seal of righteousness of the faith he had while still uncircumcised

17. The promise ... is of faith
18. Promise is sure to those who are of the faith of Abraham
19. Abraham was not weak in faith in regard to the birth to his son
20. God strengthened Abraham's faith
21. Justified by faith

23. Gentiles attained to the righteousness of faith ... they sought righteousness by faith
24. The righteousness of faith speaks ... the word of faith is near you... in your mouth ... in your heart

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Confess with your mouth the Lord Jesus... Believe in your heart that God has raised Him from the dead ... you shall be saved

25. The word of faith is preached
26. Faith comes by hearing the word of God
27. We stand by faith
28. God has dealt to each a measure of faith
29. Prophecy in proportion to our faith
30. Some are weak in the faith
31. Do you have faith? Have it to yourself before God
32. He who doubts is condemned if he eats, because he does not eat from faith ... whatever is not from faith is sin
33. Obedience to the faith

First Letter to the Corinthians

1. God is faithful
2. Your faith should not rest in the wisdom of men, but in the power of God
3. Stewards must be found faithful
4. Timothy is a faithful son
5. Some receive the gift of faith
6. Though I have all faith
7. Now abides faith ... greatest is love
8. If Christ is not risen ... your faith is empty and futile
9. Stand fast in the faith

The Second Epistle to the Corinthians

1. God is faithful
2. Not that we have dominion over your faith, but are fellow workers for your joy, for by faith you stand

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3. And since we have the same spirit of faith, according to what is written...
4. For we walk by faith, not by sight
5. But as you abound in everything – in faith, in speech, in knowledge, in all diligence, and in your love for us...
6. Having hope, that as your faith is increased...
7. Examine yourselves as to whether you are in the faith ...

The Epistle to the Galatians

1. He who formerly persecuted us now preaches the faith which he once tried to destroy.
2. Knowing that a man is not justified by the works of the law but by faith in Jesus Christ
3. Even we have believed in Christ Jesus, that we might be justified by faith in Christ and not by the works of the law, for by the works of the law no flesh shall be justified
4. The life which I now live in the flesh I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave Himself for me
5. Did you receive the Spirit by the works of the law, or by the hearing of faith?
6. He who supplies the Spirit to you and works miracles among you, does He do it by the works of the law, or by the hearing of faith?
7. Know that only those who are of faith are sons of Abraham
8. The Scripture, foreseeing that God would justify the Gentiles by faith, preached the gospel to Abraham
9. Those who are of faith are blessed with believing Abraham
10. But that no one is justified by the law in the sight of God is evident, for “the just shall live by faith.”
11. Yet the law is not of faith, but “the man who does them shall live by them.”
12. “Cursed is everyone who hangs on a tree” that the blessing of Abraham might come upon the Gentiles in Christ Jesus, that we might receive the promise of the Spirit through faith.
13. The Scripture has confined all under sin, that the promise by faith in Jesus Christ might be given to those who believe.
14. But before faith came, we were kept under guard by the law, kept for the faith which would afterward be revealed.

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15. The law was our tutor to bring us to Christ, that we might be justified by faith.
16. After faith has come, we are no longer under a tutor.
17. For you are all sons of God through faith in Christ Jesus.
18. For we through the Spirit eagerly wait for the hope of righteousness by faith.
19. For in Christ Jesus neither circumcision nor uncircumcision avails anything, but faith working through love.
20. But the fruit of the Spirit is ... faithfulness
21. As we have opportunity, let us do good to all, especially to those who are of the household of faith

The Epistle to the Ephesians

1. Faithful in Christ
2. I also heard of your faith in the Lord Jesus Christ
3. For by grace you have been saved through faith, and that not of yourselves; it is the gift of God
4. In whom we have boldness and access with confidence through faith in Him
5. that Christ may dwell in your hearts through faith
6. There is ... one faith...
7. He gave men as gifts ... till we all come to the unity of the faith...
8. Stand therefore ... taking the shield of faith with which you will be able to quench all the fiery darts of the wicked one.
9. Tychicus ... a faithful minister in the Lord
10. Peace to the brethren, and love with faith, from God the Father and the Lord Jesus Christ

The Epistle to the Phillipians

1. Being confident of this, I know that I shall remain and continue with you all for your progress and joy in faith...
2. That you stand fast in one spirit, with one mind striving together for the faith of the gospel
3. I am being poured out as a drink offering on the sacrifice and service of your faith, I am glad and rejoice with you all.

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4. I have suffered the loss of all things, and count them as rubbish, that I may gain Christ and be found in Him, not having my own righteousness, which is from the law, but that which is through faith in Christ, the righteousness which is from God by faith...

The Epistle to the Colossians

1. We give thanks ... since we hear of your faith in Christ Jesus and your love for all the saints
2. Epaphras ... is a faithful minister of Christ
3. He has reconciled you ... if indeed you continue in the faith, grounded and steadfast, and are not moved away from the hope of the gospel
4. I am with you in spirit ... rejoicing to see your good order and the steadfastness of your faith in Christ
5. As you therefore have received Christ Jesus the Lord, so walk in Him, rooted and built up in Him and established in the faith, as you have been taught, abounding in it with thanksgiving
6. In Him ... you were buried with Him in baptism, in which you also were raised with Him through faith in the working of God, who raised Him from the dead.
7. Onesimus, a faithful and beloved brother

The First Epistle to the Thessalonians

1. We give thanks for you... remembering without ceasing your work of faith...
2. Your faith toward God has gone out, so that we do not need to say anything.
3. I sent Timothy...to establish you and encourage you concerning your faith, that no one should be shaken by these afflictions; for you yourselves know that we are appointed to this.
4. I sent to know your faith, lest by some means the tempter had tempted you, and our labor might be in vain.
5. Timothy ... brought us good news of your faith and love
6. We were comforted concerning you by your faith
7. ... praying exceedingly that we may see your face and perfect what is lacking in your faith
8. ... let us who are of the day, be sober, putting on the breastplate of faith and love...
9. He who calls you is faithful, who also will do it.

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The Second Epistle to the Thessalonians

1. We thank God for you ... your faith grows exceedingly
2. We boast of you among the churches of God for your patience and faith in all your persecutions and tribulations that you endure
3. We pray always that God would count you worthy of this calling, and fulfill all the good pleasure of His goodness and the work of faith with power, that the name of our Lord Jesus Christ may be glorified in you, and you in Him...
4. ... that we may be delivered from unreasonable and wicked men; for not all have faith.
5. The Lord is faithful, who will establish you and guard you from the evil one.

The First Epistle to Timothy

1. Timothy, a true son in the faith
2. Do not give heed to fables and endless genealogies, which cause disputes rather than godly edification which is in faith.
3. The purpose of the commandment is love from a pure heart, from a good conscience, and from sincere faith, from which some having strayed, have turned aside to idle talking...
4. I thank Christ Jesus our Lord who has enabled me, because He counted me faithful, putting me into the ministry...
5. And the grace of our Lord was exceedingly abundant, with faith and love which are in Christ Jesus
6. This is a faithful saying and worthy of all acceptance...
7. Timothy ... having faith and a good conscience, which some having rejected, concerning the faith have suffered shipwreck...
8. I am speaking the truth in Christ and not lying – a teacher of the Gentiles in faith and truth
9. Nevertheless she will be saved in childbearing if they continue in faith...
10. This is a faithful saying...
11. Hold the mystery of the faith with a pure conscience
12. Be faithful in all things
13. Those who have served well as deacons obtain for themselves a good standing and great boldness in the faith which is in Christ Jesus

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14. The Spirit expressly says that in latter times some will depart from the faith ...
15. Be a good minister of Jesus Christ, nourished in the words of faith and of the good doctrine which you have carefully followed.
16. This is a faithful saying...
17. Be an example to the believers ... in faith
18. If anyone does not provide for his own , and especially for those of his household, he has denied the faith and is worse than an unbeliever.
19. ... having condemnation because they have cast off their first faith
20. The love of money is a root of all kinds of evil, for which some have strayed from the faith in their greediness, and pierced themselves through with many sorrows.
21. O man of God ... pursue faith
22. Guard what was committed to your trust ... some have strayed concerning the faith.

The Second Epistle to Timothy

1. I call to remembrance the genuine faith that is in you, which dwelt first in your grandmother Lois and your mother Eunice
2. Hold fast the pattern of sound words which you have heard from me, in faith and love which are in Christ Jesus.
3. Things you have heard from me... commit to faithful men who will be able to teach others.
4. This is a faithful saying
5. ... they overthrow the faith of some...
6. Pursue ... faith
7. ... men of corrupt minds, disapproved concerning the faith
8. You have followed my doctrine, manner of life, purpose, faith...
9. The Holy Scriptures, which are able to make you wise for salvation through faith which is in Christ Jesus
10. I have finished the race, I have kept the faith.

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The Epistle to Titus

1. Bondservant and apostle ... according to the faith of God's elect...
2. Titus, a true son in our common faith
3. Bishop must have faithful children
4. Bishop must hold fast the faithful word as he has been taught, that he may be able, by sound doctrine, both to exhort and convict those who contradict.
5. Rebuke them sharply, that they may be sound in the faith.
6. That the older men may be sound in faith
7. This is a faithful saying
8. Greet those who love us in the faith.

The Epistle to Philemon

1. I thank God ... hearing of your love and faith which you have toward the Lord Jesus and toward all the saints.
2. That the sharing of your faith may become effective by the acknowledgment of every good thing which is in you in Christ Jesus
