He is the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ

He is the Father of glory, source of every spiritual blessing, a rewarder, and a master,

Father is rich in mercy and His love is great toward us.

He is the revealer of mysteries

He is not partial

He is in heaven.

What are some of God's actions evident in the book of Ephesians?

He choose, predestines, makes men accepted in the Beloved, gives men the spirit of wisdom and revelation in the knowledge of Himself.

He opens the eyes of understanding and enlightens men by revealing to them

- the hope of His calling,
- the riches of the glory of His inheritance in the saints
- the exceeding greatness of His power toward us who believe, according to the working of His mighty power which He worked in Christ

Father created all things through Jesus Christ

Father is going to gather together in one all things in Christ – in heaven and earth – in Him

Father raised His Son from the dead

Father seated Jesus Christ at His right hand in the heavenly places, far above all principality and power and might and dominion, and every name that is named, not only in this age but also in that which is to come.

Father put all things under His feet

Father gave Jesus Christ to be head over all things to the church

Father makes men alive together with Christ

Father saves men by His grace.

Father raised us up together and made us sit together in the heavenly places in Christ Jesus,

Father is going to display to us the exceeding riches of His grace for ages to come

Father is kind toward us in Christ Jesus

Father is the giver of the gift of salvation.

He is a creator of masterpieces

He has created us in Christ Jesus for good works which He prepared before hand

He makes us fellow heirs, partakers of His promise in Christ through the gospel

God's manifold wisdom is to be made known by the church to the principalities and powers in the heavenly places,

Father accomplished His eternal purpose in Christ Jesus our Lord

He strengthens men with might through His Spirit in the inner man according to the riches of His glory

God in Christ forgave you

He directs wrath toward the sons of disobedience.

The fellowship of the mystery was hidden in God from the beginning of the ages

What are some of God's desires in the book of Ephesians?

God desires that we be rooted and grounded in love, that we comprehend with all the saints what is the width and length and depth and height, that we know the love of Christ which passes knowledge;

He desires that men be filled with all His fullness.

He desires that men understand and do His will

He desires that men be filled with the Spirit,

He desires that men use the armor He makes available so they can stand against the wiles of the devil

God desires that men understand that their battle is not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, powers, the rulers of the darkness of this age, and spiritual hosts of wickedness in the heavenly places.

God desires that men take up His armor in order to withstand the evil day:

God desires that men use the following armor: truth, righteousness, the preparation of the gospel of peace, faith, salvation, the Word, prayer

What does the book of Ephesians reveal about Jesus Christ?

In the book of Ephesians, who is Jesus?

He is our peace

He is the chief *cornerstone*,

He is the one Lord

He is an offering and a sacrifice

He is God's sweet-smelling aroma.

He is the giver of light

He is head of the church;

He is the Savior of the body.

He is the sanctifier

He cleanses with the washing of water by the word

Christ nourishes and cherishes the church

The whole family in heaven and earth is named according to Jesus Christ

In the book of Ephesians, what is His primary motive for action?

Christ loves the church

Christ has loved us

In the book of Ephesians, where does He dwell?

Christ desires to dwell in your hearts through faith;

What are some of Jesus' actions evident in the book of Ephesians?

Jesus redeems, forgives our sins and makes the riches of His grace to abound.

He makes known the mystery of His will according to His good pleasure which He purposed in Himself,

Jesus has granted us an inheritance.

Jesus predestines men.

He brings men near by His blood

He unites men, breaks down walls of separation and abolishes enmity

He reconciled the Jews and Gentiles to God in one body through the cross, thereby putting to death the enmity.

He created in Himself one new man *from* the two, *thus* making peace

He came and preached peace

He gives men the gift of the grace of God by the effective working of His power
He led captivity captive, and gave gifts to men
He ascended far above all the heavens that He might fill all things
He descended into the lower parts of the earth
He teacher men
He gave some *to be* apostles, prophets, evangelists, pastors and teachers
Through Jesus Christ we have access by one Spirit to the Father
Christ gave Himself for the church
Christ will present the church to Himself a glorious church
Christ gave Himself for us

What are some of Jesus' desires in the book of Ephesians?

Christ desires to dwell in your hearts through faith;
The Lord desires that we make melody in our heart to the Lord
The Lord desire that we submitting to one another in the fear of God.
Grace flows to us and peace follows from the Lord Jesus Christ.
The truth is in Him
Peace and love with faith proceed from God the Father and the Lord Jesus Christ.

What does the book of Ephesians reveal about the Holy Spirit?

Who is the Holy Spirit?

The Holy Spirit is the guarantee of our inheritance until the redemption of the purchased possession
The Spirit is the revealer of secrets.

What activity by the Holy Spirit is evident in the book of Ephesians?

Through Jesus Christ we have access by one Spirit to the Father
We were sealed with the Holy Spirit of promise
Unity is of the Spirit
There is one Spirit
The Holy Spirit sealed us for the day of redemption
The fruit of the Spirit *is* in all goodness, righteousness, and truth
